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### **Addressing Changes in Vaccine Recommendations – 2026**

Our goal is to build trust through open conversation, clear reasoning, and respect for the seriousness of these decisions.

We continue to **strongly support the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) immunization schedule** because it is grounded in decades of high-quality data demonstrating safety and effectiveness in preventing severe illness, hospitalization, and death. This is the same schedule that guided pediatric care for many years prior to recent federal wording changes.
